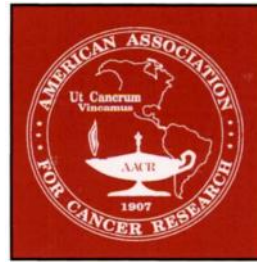

All submissions undergo peer review. 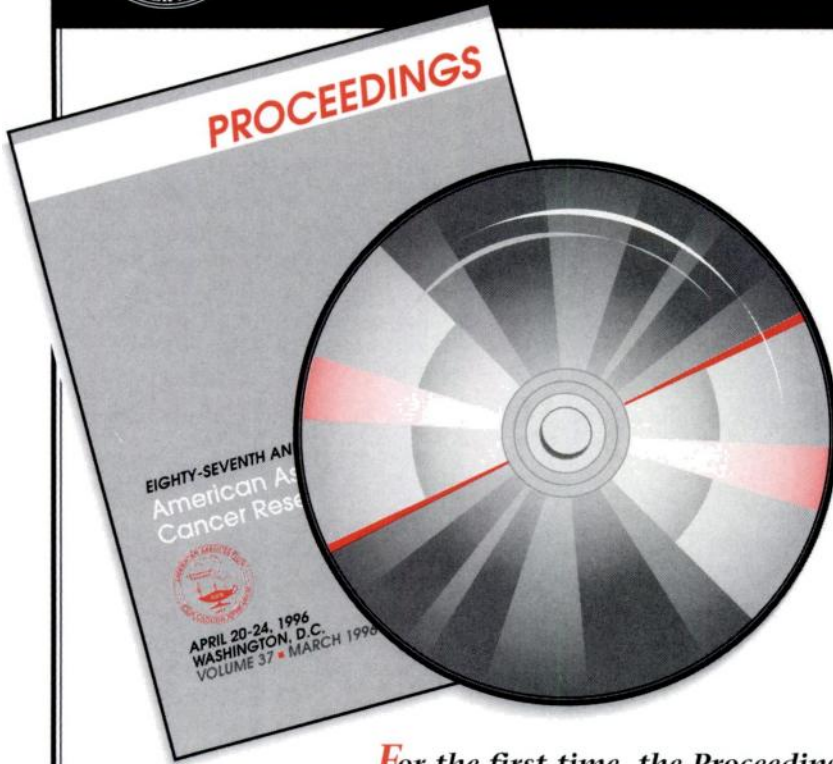
